Pantry ABC Scavenger Hunt




TIPS & IDEAS FOR USE

AT HOME: Grab a clipboard or let kids simply place their paper on the table or floor. Encourage kids to look at the packages on foods in the pantry or kitchen cabinets to find each letter of the alphabet. Be sure to model how to use gentle hands when touching glass jars. As kids find each letter have them color it on their scavenger hunt page. This can be done independently or with a helper. To extend the learning have kids say the name of the letter and the letter sound. Discuss which words (Cheerios, Raisins, etc.) the child recognizes on the environmental print on the packages.




